Feeder rates across the eastern states this week varied for most categories. Some reports suggest that the recent seasonal conditions have eased some prices on last week, as steady cattle flows are reported in the market. The physical markets trended mostly dearer week-on-week, with medium C2 yearling steers up 1¢, while the equivalent heifer portion increased 8¢/kg lwt.
