Eastern States

Feeder prices across the eastern states trended firm to slightly easier in comparison to last week, as supplies reportedly continue to flow with the poor seasonal conditions, particularly in parts of Queensland.

The physical markets also showed a general decline in average prices, with heavy C2 yearling steers back 1¢ on 192¢, while C2 grown steers were 12¢ cheaper, to average 166¢/kg lwt.
