It was a plain yarding of mostly local prime cattle, with the majority penned being cows. Not all the export processors were present and those operating were selective in their purchases. Some restocker buyer support helped put a floor in the price declines of 3 score medium and heavy weight cows. Heavy bulls met subdued export processor demand.

Medium weight 3 score grown heifers sold to 123c and averaged 115c, while heavy weight 4 score grown heifers topped at 136c and averaged 133c/kg. Light and medium weight 2 score cows sold to 91c, with most sold between 67c and 80c/kg. Medium weight 3 score cows earned to 112c and averaged 98c, while heavy weight 3 score cows made to 114c and averaged 108c/kg. Heavy weight 4 score cows hit 121c and averaged 120c/kg. Heavy weight bulls sold to 141c and averaged 128c/kg.
