Feeder prices across the eastern states remained relatively firm to slighter cheaper than the previous week, with some reports of heavy weights harder to source due to the drought conditions.

The physical markets experienced the most price variation, with light C2 yearling steers, back 2¢ on a week ago to 185¢, while the heavy lines improved 1¢, to average 193¢/kg.
