Limited numbers of prime cattle were yarded again this week. Some good quality bullocks were penned, while a mix of cows were consigned. There was more competition between the major processor buyers for suitable grown steers, bullocks, bulls and cows. Prices improved for bullocks and good mature heavy bulls attracted an 8c/kg average price increase. All the usual export processors were operating on all classes of cows, with prices lifting 8c to 12c/kg across all categories of cows.

Medium weight steers reached 188c and most sold between 155c and 166c/kg. Good bullocks hit 187c, with most selling between 165c and 170c/kg. Light and medium weight 2 score cows made to 101c and averaged between 78c and 92c/kg. The medium weight 3 score cows hit 128c and averaged 117c, up 8c/kg. Heavy weight 3 score cows earned to 129c and 123c, up 8c/kg. Good heavy 4 score cows sold to 136c and averaged 135c, up 9c/kg. Heavy bulls hit 170c and averaged 146c, up 8c/kg.
