The number of cattle yarded increased for a total of 1,200 head. Young cattle were well supplied, while there was a fair penning of grown cattle. The yarding of young cattle consisted of several pens of yearlings and vealers were in larger numbers. Quality of the young cattle was much improved, with some good runs of well finished yearlings, milk vealers and supplementary fed cattle offered throughout the sale. There were also pens of well-bred steers and heifers suitable for feeder and restocker buyers.

Competition was stronger from processors and wholesalers, with vealers to slaughter selling 10c dearer, ranging from 136c to193c/kg. Restocker vealer steers ranged from 145c to 186c/kg. Trade yearlings saw little change, with steers selling from 165c to 187c, while heifers topped at 176c/kg. Feeder steers sold on a strong market with the better bred cattle making premium prices. Medium weight feeder steers sold from 170c to 190c and light feeder steers topped at 209.2c/kg.

The yarding of export cattle was made up of a good yarding of cows and a fair supply of grown steers and heifers. Bullocks and steers were slightly easier mainly due to quality, topping at 172c, while heifers sold to 154c/kg. The cow market was easier by 4c to 5c for heavy weights, while most other cows held firm.
