Average numbers of prime cattle were penned, with cows and heavy bulls dominating the yarding. Prices hit record levels and export processor demand was extremely strong from Queensland and NSW processors. All the usual export processor buyers were in attendance and cows jumped 11c/kg to 34c in price, while good heavy bulls lifted 19c/kg on average.

Medium weight grown steers topped at 212c and averaged 211c, up 26c, while bullocks made to 207c, up 25c/kg. Medium weight grown heifers earned to 204c and averaged 197c, up 30c, while heavy weight 4 score grown heifers reached 208c and averaged 207c, up 36c/kg. Medium weight 2 score cows sold to 115c and averaged 111c, up 11c, while medium weight 3 score cows reached 178c and averaged 155c, up 22c/kg. Medium weight 4 score cows topped at 185c and averaged 181c, up 29c/kg. Heavy weight 4 score cows sold to 199c and averaged 188c, up 30c/kg. Medium weight bulls sold to 213c and averaged 195c, up 25c, while heavy weight bulls topped at 213c and averaged 199c, up 19c/kg.
