

Detailed saleyard report - cattle

Mixed quality consignments of cattle were yarded from north-west parts of the state, while some good quality lines were penned from the local south-west supply area. Good numbers of restocker buyers were in attendance and a full panel of feedlot buyers were operating. Good quality steers and heifers continued to sell to solid market prices, how secondary lines reportedly met subdued demand. Export processors were more selective when purchasing store cows and prices were cheaper across score 2 and 3 medium and heavy weight cows.

Light weight yearling steers sold to 222c and averaged 202c, down 4c, while D muscled sorts reached 186c and averaged between 139c and 168c/kg. Medium weight yearling steers to feed hit 216c and averaged 199c, down 2c, while those returning to the paddock topped at 208c and averaged 201c, down 3c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed earned to 213c and averaged 206c, up 2c/kg. Light weight yearling heifers to the paddock topped at 207c and averaged 199c, while most sold to 186c and averaged 171c/kg. Those going to feedlot buyers reached 184c and averaged 172c, up 3c/kg. Medium weight yearling heifers to feed made to 199c, while most sold to 187c and averaged 175c, down 11c/kg. Heavy weight yearling heifers to feed earned to 192c and averaged 187c, down 5c/kg.

Medium weight grown steers to feed reached 194c and averaged 188c, while heavy weight grown steers to feed sold to 186c/kg. A few good grown heifers made to 184c/kg. Medium weight 2 score cows earned to 120c and averaged 110c, while medium and heavy weight 3 score cows reached 175c and averaged between 145c and 167c/kg. Good heavy weight 4 score cows sold to 188c/kg.
