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Prices across most categories declined by 5¢ and more in places as cattle supply continue to be buoyant. Heavy weight lines are still in good supply however rates have started to ease, especially through saleyards this week. Demand for heifers has also slipped by 5¢ to 11¢/kg and more in places which is considerably more than steers in recent weeks.
