Feeder prices increased again week-on-week, following recent rain across eastern NSW and in anticipation of further rain pushing north into south-east Queensland over the weekend. Out of the paddock price mostly increased 3-4¢, while in the physical market prices lifted 10¢/kg on the largest throughput categories.
