Saleyard feeder prices continued their upward trend, with most categories 7-10¢/kg dearer week-on-week. The Wagga market (29 June) started the new week on a strong note, with medium and heavy C2 and C3 feeder steers averaging in excess of 310¢/kg.

Paddock prices were sticky, with many contributors reluctant to push quotes higher. On domestic paddock sales, quotes from NSW were mostly 5¢/kg dearer although some northern quotes pulled back slightly, keeping the trend firm. The domestic heifer trend was not quoted this week due to a new contributor quoting on the category.
