Out of the paddock feeder quotes continued to trend dearer, with domestic paddock prices up 5¢ and export lines up mostly 3¢/kg.

Trends in the physical market were mixed. Medium weight yearling steers held firm or continued to improve, with feeder buyers competing against the NSW restocker, while the heavy weights could not maintain the previous week's gains.
