Eastern states feeder prices lifted amidst widespread rain across the east coast. The physical market mostly rallied in excess of 10¢/kg and paddock prices followed suit. Saleyard and paddock feeder steer prices are now averaging above 300¢/kg, particularly supported by demand out of Queensland.
