The supply of store cattle remained below average. The quality of cattle penned was mixed, with restocker and feedlot buyer demand staying solid. Very light weight steers hit 396c, while very light weight heifer calves reached 374c/kg. All steers suitable for feed improved 3c to 8c on average. Droughtmaster cows with 1 to 4 month old calves topped at \$1825/unit.

Steer calves sold to 396c and averaged 378c, up 22c, while heifer calves made to 374c and averaged 345c, up 21c/kg. Light weight yearling steers earned to 377c and averaged between 336c and 357c for good quality sorts. Medium weight yearling steers to feed topped at 340c and averaged 328c, up 3c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed reached 338c and averaged 326c, up 8c/kg. Light weight yearling heifers sold to 358c and mostly made between 311c and 339c/kg. Medium weight yearling heifers made to 329c and averaged 317c to feed onto the supermarket trade. Heavy weight yearling heifers to feed earned to 310c and averaged 305c/kg.

Medium weight grown steers to feed reached 309c and mostly made between 306c and 308c/kg. Grown heifers to feed sold to 274c/kg. The 2 score cows to restockers sold between 194c and 218c/kg. The medium weight 3 score cows hit 256c and averaged 240c/kg. Cows and calves averaged \$1408/unit.
