Eastern States

report date 13 May 2016

Feeder prices finished dearer across the eastern states week-on-week, with prices improving throughout most categories. In the physical market, heavy C3 yearling steers jumped 7c, while grown steers were 5c dearer, averaging 283c/kg lwt. Domestic lines from the paddock gained 2c, with short fed steers to export following a similar trend.
