Eastern states feeder prices continued to trend dearer this week, with widespread showers having an effect on availability. Export paddock sections finished notably stronger - with medium fed angus lines averaging 12c/kg lwt higher. Those in the physical market improved overall, while domestic categories were mostly firm to dearer.
