## **Eastern States**

report date 12 Aug 2016

The eastern states feeder indicators continued to trend dearer again this week - with the majority of contributors lifting quotes and others holding firm week-on-week. Some domestic paddock quotes lifted as much as 10c, while those in the physical market recorded the most significant improvement - with medium C3 yearling heifers averaging 17c/kg lwt higher on where they settled the week prior.

Please note that the export short-fed Angus trend is not included this week, with one contributor returning to quote.
