A cheaper trend was evident across the board as most contributors reduced rates, while some made no changes due to the short trading week. Demand at both the wholesale and particularly on the export market has been slow which has been a major reason behind current changes to rates.

Rain, predominately on the Coastal and Northern regions, is expected to hold up cattle supply. The quality of the finished young cattle and grown steers has generally been good.
