Numbers held steady but the quality of the cattle yarded declined. Processor buyers only had a small number of bullocks to bid on and prices held firm to 1c/kg dearer. Grain fed grown heifers struggled to find enough buyer competition and only reached 161c, while heavy grown heifers fell by 13c/kg on average. The quality of cows on offer was very patchy and prices trended down by 3c to 6c/kg.

Plainer muscled medium weight yearling heifers sold to 161c and averaged 148c, up 3c/kg.

Medium weight grown steers averaged 171c, unchanged on last weeks rates, while the few pens of bullocks topped at 171c and also averaged close to 171c, up 1c/kg. Grown heifers averaged 161c, while heavier sorts of grown heifers averaged 150c, down 13c/kg. A couple of D muscled full mouth manufacturing steers averaged 144c/kg.

Medium weight 3 score cows topped at 145c and averaged 131c, down 3c, while medium weight 4 score cows lost 4c to sell to 146c and average around 139c/kg. Heavy weight 4 score cows earned to 150c and averaged 141c, down 6c/kg. Heavy bulls averaged 151c, down 4c/kg.
