## **Eastern States**

Paddock rates registered a dearer trend, with a number of contributors in northern regions increasing rates in order to attract additional cattle. Cattle supplies entering feedlots has reportedly slipped recently, with producers not keen to sell at current price levels.

Saleyard feeder prices were mainly dearer due to the reduced yardings in the eastern states, which increased competition.
