Rates for younger cattle realised a stable trend this week, as all categories recorded a firm trend. The supply of prime cattle remains tight in places, which has seen some processors work at reduced capacity. Cow categories edged higher with one processor trying to attract greater numbers. Supply of yearling cattle has begun to lift, with several drafts in good condition.
