Paddock feeder rates edged higher for short and mid fed cattle after a number of contributors lifted rates. Competition has increased due to a tightening in supply of suitable short fed cattle in recent weeks. The lower A\$ has given some confidence to feeder operators, which has contributed to firmer demand.

Saleyard prices were mixed yet prices for heavier short fed cattle were mainly dearer.
