The number of cattle yarded was up slightly and consisted of a small penning of vealers and cows, while yearlings and grown steers were well supplied. The quality of the young cattle was fairly mixed with a large percentage of steers and heifers going to feeders and restockers.

Competition was strong with vealers to slaughter holding firm topping at 218.2c, while restocker vealer steers were slightly easier which was mainly quality related. The few trade yearling steers held firm with sales to 210c, while trade yearling heifers sold to a top of 215c/kg. Feeder steers and heifers held firm with medium weights selling to 215.2c/kg.

The yarding of export cattle was made up of a good run of grown steers that were mainly crop finished and sold to a dearer trend. The for the younger steer made to 207c with most selling around 201c/kg. The cow market improved slightly with heavy weights selling to 160c/kg.
