A smaller improved quality yarding containing 543 beef and limited numbers of pastoral bred cows, together with 78 bulls sold to solid South East and Victorian processor competition at generally dearer levels as the operating buyers struggled to build large lines.

A few Friesian grown heifers sold at 136c and 154c/kg.

The D3 to C5 medium and heavy beef cows sold from 142c to 164c with four magnificent Charolais heavyweights reaching 176c/kg. This tended to leave most cows selling at prices 2c to 12c dearer, and generally 290c to 325c/kg cwt. A small number of pastoral breeds sold from 146c to 165c to be averaging 315c/kg cwt. Restockers sourced a mixture of quality with some possibly in calf from 137c to 149c/kg. Medium and heavy bulls to Victorian processors sold mainly from 145c to 181c, to be averaging 11c/kg more.
