Numbers increased in a mixed quality yarding, with an increased supply of over conditioned grades. The usual turnout of regular buyers attended and competition was steady across most categories.

Heavy cows sold to strong demand resulting in prices holding firm. The D3 medium weight pens were in reasonable supply and they averaged 147.8c/kg. Heavy 4 score cows made from 150c to 164.2c/kg.

There was a good quality selection of 48 bulls offered and prices were 2c/kg dearer. A single B muscled bull reached a top price of 192.6c/kg.
