## AuctionsPlus week ending 2 Nov 2012

Cattle numbers were reasonably static this week, totalling 3,972 head. Sheep and lambs jumped to 58,448 head, including the Paraway wether lamb sale. Good rain across southern NSW brought a few buyers out of the woodwork, with over 150 registered bidders logging in to Thursday's sheep sale, and 215 having a look at cattle today.

Numbers of Merino ewes dropped this week, and combined with quality offerings, resulted in better prices and clearance rates than we have seen recently for this article. Young ewes topped at \$154 for October shorn, Pooginook blood hoggets at Cootamundra, while mixed age and old ewes sold from \$75.50 to \$89.50. First cross ewes were hard to sell; however several lines of quality Dorper ewes sold well, topping at \$154 for Kaya blood young ewes at Wellington.

With many hopeful that this week's rain event will improve sheep prices, processors seemed prepared to up their rates toward the end of the week for the right sheep. Wethers in Tasmania with an inch on their backs sold for 210c or \$47, plus freight to the mainland for processing, and export weight Merino wether hoggets out of Hay made 256c or \$65 including a half inch skin. However processors were outpriced on a quality line of two year old Hazeldean blood wethers estimated to dress 30kg, which met strong competition form restockers and exporters to make \$72.

Store lamb numbers continue to steadily increase, and with some quality lambs available out of southern NSW this week, we are starting to get a stronger sense of what prices will do once the bigger numbers further south hit the marketplace. Only one line of lambs over 40kg sold this week – good quality second crosses out of Young, making \$76. 38kg lambs made \$67-\$70.50, while the 32-34kg range had the biggest numbers, making from \$59 to\$68. Lighter lambs weighing 26-27kg sold from \$54 to \$58.50.

The Paraway sale saw 21,000 wether lambs sell to an average of \$42.70, topping at \$65. There was plenty of activity from online bidders, who secured 11 of the 35 lots.

Cow and calf numbers dropped right back this week; Angus heifers with their first calf at foot sold for \$1160 at Wagga Wagga, and in southern QLD Brangus cows and calves made \$1130. PTIC heifers were also in shorter supply, making to \$780 in Qld for Santa and Santa cross rising two year olds in calf to Angus. In NSW mixed age PTIC cows ranged n price from \$655 to \$845 for young Angus cows.

We did not see the price spikes for young cattle that have been noted in the yards this week; however quality was mixed, and most steers offered were crossbreds, whereas prices we reported for last week were based primarily on black cattle. In Qld, 380kg Euro cross yearling steers sold to 183c; 350-375kg steers in NSW made 190c. At the lighter end, weaner steers in southern QLD averaged 221c, and in NSW little steers 250kg or less averaged 215c. Weaner heifers out of QLD and northern NSW sold well to an average of 192c.
