The rain over the supply area reduced numbers dramatically and there were virtually no calves and vealers penned, and only a small sample of yearling steers and heifers. A few pens of heavy steers and bullocks and a small sample of cows were also included in a line-up. Buyer attendance was good and most were keen to make purchases. Values generally improved across most classes of young cattle, and steers and bullocks lifted in value by 5c to 7c, and cows gained a similar amount.

Light and medium weight yearling steers to feed mostly sold around 222c with sales to 225c/kg. A couple of heavy yearling steers to the trade averaged 204c to make to 218.2c/kg. A small selection of good quality medium weight yearling heifers to feed averaged 15c dearer at 208c and sold to 215.2c/kg. A handful of slaughter classes averaged and sold at similar prices.

Heavy steers to export slaughter averaged 187c and a few pens of bullocks made to 194.6c to average 192c/kg. A small number of heavy cows averaged 162c and made to 173.2c/kg. Heavy Bulls made to 171.2c/kg.
