Domestic feeder rates were firm to slightly lower, as demand for suitable short fed cattle was mixed with contributors both lowering and increasing rates. Cattle supply has begun to lift with the cooler weather, and demand for grain fed meat remains weak.

Physical market prices were also lower as numbers increased and demand fell away in the lead up to the Easter holiday period.
