Most contributors left their rates unchanged following the recent rains with many waiting to see what impact this has on supply. Most feeders do have plenty of cattle offered to them at present. A couple of contributors at the lower end of the price range lifted 5c to 10c/kg.

The cheaper trend at physical markets continued for yearling heifers and grown steers while the yearling steer portion met improved demand.
