After no sale last week agents yarded an increased number. Quality continues to be mixed and there was an increased number of well finished cattle. Yearlings made up the majority of the offering. The usual buyers were present and competing in a dearer market.

Yearling steers to feed lifted 8c to 10c/kg. Medium weight steers sold from 170c to 219c and heavy weight steers received from 175c to 201c/kg. Those to processors were 5c dearer ranging from 186c to 227c/kg for medium and heavy weights. The heifer portion to feed was 9c dearer selling from 150c to 192c/kg. Those to slaughter ranged from 170c to 203c/kg.

Heavy steers and bullocks were 2c to 3c dearer receiving from 175c to 196c/kg. Grown heifers sold from 155c to 168c/kg. Cows were 3c to 4c dearer with heavy 2 scores averaging 131c and 3 and 4 scores selling from 134c to 150c/kg.
