Some contributors lifted rates 5¢ however the majority remained firm as supply is easily attainable. Cattle in the north remain in good condition, while the south limited numbers of well conditioned cattle are available.

At the physical market prices remained mixed across the categories. Medium yearling steers trended lower while yearling heifers generally sold at higher prices. Grown steers remained firm.
