Rates have remained unchanged again except for a slight decline recorded to MSA rates from a contributor. Cattle supply has remained steady however any influx may have a negative impact on rates. The current demand situation has meant that a number of processors are only sourcing minimal numbers on a weekly basis rather than having too many cattle booked in advance. The varying A\$ is continuing to impact on exporters, while uncertainty remains around the introduction of the carbon tax and its effect on the processing sector.
