Large lines of young steers and heifers dominated the large yarding. Prices improved 6c/kg for light yearling steers, while light yearling heifers varied in price. Good numbers of restocker were present and a full panel of feedlot buyers were also active. The majority cattle were from the local south west supply area with the occasional good quality line from central west. Heavy yearling steers to feed lifted 2c/kg, while a few heavy weight yearling heifers to feed were also dearer. Light weight yearling heifers to feed fell 7c/kg, but those going back to the paddock lifted 12c/kg. The grown steers to feed found plenty of buyer competition and gained 10c/kg, while bullocks remained unchanged. A small sample of grown heifers to processors lost 4c/kg.

Light yearling steers topped at 234c/kg and averaged 219c, to be 6c/kg dearer, while those with more condition topped at 238c and averaged 237c/kg. Medium weight yearling steers to feed made to 227c and averaged 196c, a fall of 8c/kg, while those to restocker buyers sold to 231c and averaged 208c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed reached 201c and averaged 195c/kg. The C muscled light weight yearling heifers to feedlots averaged 189c, while those to processors made to 208c and averaged 206c/kg. The D muscled light yearling heifers to feed topped at 188c and averaged 181c to be 7c/kg cheaper, while those to processors made to 200c and averaged 189c/kg. Light weight yearling heifers to restockers sold to 194c and averaged 191c/kg. Medium weight yearling heifers to feed averaged 150c/kg, while those to processors sold to 148c and averaged 140c/kg. There were a few very good quality heavy weight yearling heifers to feed averaged 194c/kg.

The medium weight grown steers to feed sold to 187c and averaged 175c to be 10c/kg dearer, while bullocks averaged 178c/kg. Grown heifers to processors made to 165c and averaged 155c/kg. Medium weight 4 score cows reached 164c and averaged 155c/kg.
