Producers took advantage of the fine weather and supply by more than doubled. A fair representation of buyers was present and operating, however one export processor was absent from the buying panel. The overall standard of the heavy steers and bullocks was generally good, while a mixed quality line-up of cows were penned. Heavy steers and bullocks to export slaughter lost some of the previous weeks gains to average 6c/kg cheaper. Plain cows met a very dear market, while the better lines averaged 4c to 7c/kg less against the wet sale the previous week.

Heavy steers to export slaughter averaged just under 180c and made to 183.2c/kg. A large selection of good heavy bullocks mostly sold around 180c while some young lines made to 188c/kg. A handful of full mouth bullocks averaged 164c/kg.

Restockers were very active on plain cows with most sales around 126c to 134c/kg. Medium weight 3 scores to processors averaged 135c, and the better 4 scores 141c/kg. A fair number of good heavy cows averaged 145c with the occasional sale to 160c/kg. Heavy Bulls made to 181.2c/kg.
