## **Eastern States**

report date 19 Oct 2012

The majority of contributors have left rates unchanged as supply across the eastern states remains steady. One contributor did however ease domestic prices by 5¢/kg. Quality continues decrease as the dry hot weather affects the majority of cattle in Queensland, while the southern states have some better quality lines available.

At physical markets prices were generally mixed across all categories.
