AuctionsPlus market comment week ending 11 Jan 2013

Our first sale week of 2013 saw a reasonable offering of 2,668 cattle and 23,176 sheep and lambs. Buyer activity was somewhat subdued however, with some still enjoying the holiday break, many occupied with the southern weaner sales, and others managing bushfires that have affected numerous areas this week.

A large offering out of Tasmania saw the only Merino ewe sales for the week, with young ewes selling for \$80 and old ewes \$30-\$34. In the same sale, 57kg Merino wethers sold to a mainland export buyer for \$39.

A limited number of lamb sales saw prices steady to slightly firmer on the last week of 2012. 28kg second crosses sold for \$49; 36kg first and second crosses out of Tasmania made \$55-\$57, and good quality Composites in southern NSW weighing 45kg sold for \$73. Processors were active this week, buying light lambs for 330c, and old ewes with a 3" jacket estimated to dress 20kg for 198c, both including skin value.

The Eastern States cattle sale seemed more affected by external factors than sheep; as well as a mixed quality offering and many small lines, this resulted in higher passed in rates than we have seen in some time. Joined females remain hard to sell, with only one lot achieving a result, being PTIC Angus heifers out of Moss Vale that made \$860.

Females with calves at foot out of QLD and northern NSW attracted more competition; rising four year old Angus cows with Angus calves out of Tenterfield were the top price of the day at \$1030. Just over the border at Dirranbandi, Angus cows with Santa calves made \$725. Quality yearling Santa heifers out of northern NSW met with a flurry of bidding activity, making to \$700 – the best price we have seen for unjoined heifers recently, at an equivalent of 191c/kg.

Weaner and yearling steers out of SA only received local competition; however, this was enough to push rates to be on par with what is being achieved at the southern sales. We followed the trend with similar c/kg rates for the heavier end of the offering, and less demand for lighter steers. 300-350kg black steers were making 180c, while the best rates were for 380kg-430kg steers, selling for 183c-186c; 430kg black steers made the top price of \$785. In the north, light steers weighing less than 250kg out of QLD sold from 170c to 194c.
