Numbers dropped though quality improved slightly with some better lines of finished and plainer cattle offered. Yearlings made up the majority of the yarding along with a handy penning of cows. The usual buyers were present and competing in a dearer market.

Vealer steers and heifers to processors sold from 185c to 209c/kg. Yearling steers to feed lifted 9c/kg. Medium weights sold from 155c to 191c and heavy weights sold from 155c to 183c/kg. The finished lines to slaughter lifted 5c to 7c selling from 168c to 202c/kg. The heifer portion to feed lifted 15c ranging from 135c to 175c/kg. Those to processors were 8c better selling from 150c to 190c/kg.

Heavy steers and bullocks were limited in number and held steady selling from 162c to 182c/kg. Grown heifers sold from 130c to 158c/kg. Cows were 5c to 10/kg better. Heavy 2 scores sold from 114c to 136c and the 3 and 4 scores from 128c to 145c/kg.
