## **Detailed saleyard report - cattle**

Market information provided by MLA's National Livestock Reporting Service

**Roma Prime** report date 23 May 2013 Yarding Change <del>-298</del> comparison date 16/05/2013

A small number of cattle were yarded. Rainfall of more than 25mm across the region prevented the movement of most cattle. There were no real bullocks yarded with a top of 148c/kg achieved for a few pens of plainer bullocks with good fat cover. Most grown heifers held firm in price, while cows were slightly dearer in places.

Medium weight grown steers sold to 138c and averaged 133c, while a couple of bullocks made 148c/kg. The 3 score grown heifers sold mostly between 118c and 125c, while a pen of good quality grown heifers hit 136c and most averaged 127c/kg. The medium weight cows sold between 112c and 116c, while heavy weight 3 score cows averaged 109c and 4 score sorts sold to 115c/kg. Most bulls sold between 125c and 135c, while a very good quality heavy bull reached 143c/kg.
