Prices have remained unchanged across most categories, with reports suggesting processors are still booked with plenty of supply.

Quality has improved in places, with oats to feed, yet plainer lines are expected as winter approaches, particularly affecting young cattle. Reports also suggest that supplementary fed cattle are less attainable.
