Numbers fell again and quality continues to be mixed. There were some good lines of well finished, supplementary fed cattle offered. Yearlings made up the majority of the yarding along with a good penning of cows. The usual buyers were present and competing in a mostly steady market.

Yearling steers to processors were firm to 2c/kg better. Medium and heavyweights sold from 180c to 210c/kg. Those to feeders lifted 8c/kg. Medium weights received from 150c to 206c, while the heavy weights made from 175c to 196c/kg. The heifer portion to feed lifted 2c, receiving from 150c to 160c/kg. Medium weights to slaughter sold from 208c, with the heavy weights ranging from 164c to 185c/kg.

Heavy steers and bullocks held firm selling from 180c to 192c/kg. Grown heifers averaged 143c/kg. Cows held fairly firm. Heavy 2 score cows sold from 124c to 134c and 3 &4 score sold from 139c to 151c/kg.
