## **Detailed saleyard report - cattle**

The supply of stock remained virtually unchanged despite some scattered falls of rain in parts of the supply area. There was a wide variation in quality, and a large consignment of bullocks from the far western corner of the state dominated the selling pens. Buyer attendance was good and all were keen to obtain their market share. Prices lifted accordingly and heavy grown steers and bullocks averaged 7c to 8c/kg better. Cows also met a dearer trend, with price improvements of 10c/kg.

Heavy grown steers averaged 182c and sold to 185c/kg. Bullocks mostly sold around 183c, with some supplementary fed lines making to 190c/kg to return \$1369/head. The large number of full mouth bullocks were not penalised and attracted stronger competition from processors to average close to 179c, with a few pens to 182c/kg.

Medium weight 3 score cows lifted in price to average 127c and sold to 128c/kg. A fair sample of good heavy cows made to a top of 156c to average 10c dearer at 151c/kg. Heavy bulls were also in demand to reach a top of 175c to average 166c/kg.
