Numbers jumped significantly this sale and quality was similar to the previous week. There was good numbers of finished cattle, particularly the heavier end, along with the plainer lines and those suited to restockers. Yearlings made up the majority of the offering along with a good number of cows. The usual buyers were present and competing strongly in a dearer market.

Yearling steers to processors lifted 10c receiving from 165c to 195c/kg. Those to feeders were 10c to 12c better with middle and heavyweights selling from 160c to 193c/kg. Light steers to restockers sold from 140c to 192c/kg. Medium weight heifer to slaughter held firm selling from 144c to 165c/kg. Heavyweights lifted 6c receiving 130c to 157c/kg. Plainer lines to feeders sold from 130c to 157c/kg.

Heavy steers and bullocks were 8c dearer selling from 157c to 195c/kg. Grown heifers sold from 150c to 169c/kg. A handy penning of cows saw prices lift 6c/kg. Heavy 2 score selling from 120c to 139c and 3 & 4 score from 140c to 150c/kg.
