Detailed saleyard report - cattle

Great Southern Saleyard report date 24 Jul 2014 Yarding -55 comparison date 17/07/2014

Numbers eased as rainfall in the northern supply areas restricted transports, evidently prices increased. Cow numbers were again reduced which saw processors keen to source both plain conditioned and well covered lines with export prices up by 20¢ to 25¢/kg.

Good quality grain fed steers ranged from 200¢ to 229¢, while the limited number of trade heifers averaged close to 205¢/kg. Medium to heavy weight store conditioned steers sold between 221¢ to 249¢, to average 10¢ dearer week-on-week, while the heifer portion topped at 219¢ to average 207¢/kg.

Plain conditioned cows ranged from 130¢ to 159¢, averaging 138¢, while medium weight lines averaged 173¢, up 25¢/kg. Heavy, well-conditioned cows ranged from 185¢ to 200¢ averaging 192¢, up 20¢/kg on last week's levels. The majority of the bulls offered ranged from 130¢ to 167¢/kg.
