Numbers almost doubled and quality was mixed, with most weights and grades represented. Buying competition was strong over all categories, however the market did ease a few cents. Major processors from northern NSW, South Australia, Queensland and Victoria were in attendance and operating.

Well finished cows made up a substantial portion of the yarding, which resulted in prices easing 4c/kg. The better finished lines made from 190c to 216c/kg. The 2 and 3 score cows were in reasonable supply and this category sold to strong competition from all processors, with leaner young cows selling to premium prices. The D2 and D3 cows made from 166c to 206c/kg. Friesian cows were in reasonable supply and prices were generally unchanged for the lighter weight portion.

Heavy well shaped bulls sold to solid demand benefiting from a large gallery of buyers. Well shaped heavy B and C muscled bulls made from 211c to 239c/kg.
