

## Detailed saleyard report - cattle

There were approximately 480 cows and 20 bulls penned, representing an increase of 240 head week-on-week. The usual buying group was present and operating in a generally firm market. Quality varied, with heavy weight beef cows well supplied and a larger proportion of lighter weighted cows penned. Demand was solid from processors keen to secure a share of the larger offering, while there was a far better draft of light and medium weight cows suited to turn out which sold to strong demand from graziers. Most cows sold at similar prices with the odd sale 2c to 4c/kg dearer. Heavy weight bulls sold to firm demand, however quality varied significantly and prices reflected this.

Most light and medium weight cows sold from 150c to 190c/kg. Heavy weight cows made mostly between 165c and 228c/kg. Heavy weight bulls sold between 215c and 263c/kg.
