There were approximately 150 cows and 20 bulls penned representing an increase of 60 head week-on-week. The usual buying group was present but not all operating fully in a softer market. Quality was mixed with a good selection of well finished heavy weights and a few poorer drafts in the light weights. Most lighter and leaner cows sold firm while heavy weights eased up to 10c/kg. Quality dropped in the bull offering and competition held firm.

Most light and medium weight cows sold from 202c to 248c/kg. Heavy weight cows made mostly between 225c and 298c after a top of 315c/kg for a young Euro cow with a good yield potential. Heavy weight bulls made from 266c to 314c/kg.
