There were approximately 180 cows and 10 bulls penned representing an increase of 20 head week-on-week. Most of the usual buying group was present, but not all operating in a firm market. Quality remained mixed in the limited offering, with a smaller proportion of poor conditioned light weights penned. Cows sold from firm to 5c/kg dearer across most grades, while the heavy weight bulls held firm.

Most light and medium weight cows sold from 200c to 258c/kg. Heavy weight cows made mostly between 242c and 295c after a top of 300c/kg for a younger Euro cow. Heavy weight bulls sold between 290c and 308c/kg.
