Positions Available

We require an active, honest, enthusiastic, non-smoking male/female couple for full time work in our intensive northern rangelands grazing system. The positions include predominately working independently in all aspects of station work. The two successful applicants will be handling large numbers of stock with mob sizes between 600 to 1,000 head unassisted using low stress stock handling methods while shifting mobs of cattle on a regular basis. We handle between 3,000 and 8,000 head of cattle per year from varying clients around the state, settling them into our intensive grazing system. The couple will be required to manage all cattle husbandry, water and fencing management and maintenance, paddock grazing charts and holistic grazing management of native perennial grasses within our rangelands. You may also be asked to occasionally assist in our contracting, accommodation and tourism enterprises.

Duties May Include

Routine water runs and associated maintenance, cattle training, paddock moves, maintain grazing charts and fences, yard building, machinery and vehicle maintenance, machinery operator (grader, skid steer, 930 Loader), cooking (possibility of filling in when cook is away), cleaning, gardening and tour guide. Because of the nature of our various enterprises, other jobs may arise, so we would appreciate your flexibility.

Experience/Requirements

Low stress stock handling course or experience, competent motorbike rider, horse experience and/or riding an advantage, rangeland or holistic experience, White Card, excellent communicator, weld, driver's license, experience with machinery maintenance. Excellent physical fitness is essential for both applicants. Requires 12 to 24 months of specific experience in these roles of holistic grazing and low stress stock handling.

Location

Cheela Plains Station is in the Pilbara Region of Western Australia on the Nanutarra/Munjina Road, 180 kms east of the Nanutarra T-Junction. The nearest town is Paraburdoo at 90 kms to the south east and Tom Price 130 kms to the east.
