About the role

The role is based in Glen Innes and is reporting to the Livestock Manager who is located remotely. The purpose of the role is to inspect and purchase livestock, coordinate livestock supply with Livestock Manager to meet daily, weekly, monthly demand schedule for cattle intake. Inspect and coordinate Rangers Valley backgrounding cattle into the demand schedule. Generate and support livestock performance monitoring.

Responsibilities include but not limited to:

- Purchase of livestock as directed.
- Collation and supply of producer feedback system.
- Completion of livestock input and commentary to all feedlot intake plans.
- Physical review and coordination with RV Property Manager on all cattle either holding or backgrounding on RV properties.
- Performance data review, completion of various monitors and supply to various management teams.
- Invoicing as directed.
- Cattle arrival compliance issues follow up.
- Cattle system, support as required data collection and accuracy thereof information.
