Yarding numbers increased 30% for a very large prime cattle sale. Quality was mixed with only a limited number of grown steers and bullocks penned. Cows were in good supply and majority were in fair to good condition. All the usual export processors were more reserved when purchasing with major export processors being selective on heavy cows and bulls. Bullocks declined 11c and grown heifers dropped 19c/kg on average.

Grown steers sold to 234c and averaged 230c, down 12c, while bullocks topped at 235c and averaged 233c, down 11c/kg. Medium weight grown heifers reached 210c and averaged 209c, down 19c, while heavy weight grown heifers sold to 214c/kg. Medium weight 2 score cows earned to 163c and averaged 155c, down 12c/kg. Medium weight 3 score cows made to 202c and averaged 178c, down 22c/kg. Heavy weight 3 score cows topped at 199c and averaged 188c, down 19c, while heavy weight 4 score cows reached 207c and averaged 200c, down 20c/kg. Heavy bulls hit 243c and averaged 225c, down 6c/kg.
